

STEPS TO CONVERT FROM PROPANE TO NATURAL GAS

CONVERSION CHECKLIST: ELKO COUNTY



STEP 1

Contact Southwest Gas to sign up for natural gas service and, if interested, schedule a free pre-conversion inspection.



STEP 2

Select a contractor and meet to determine which appliances can be converted or need to be replaced.



STEP 3

Your contractor will obtain the necessary permit from the Elko County Building & Safety Department.



STEP 4

To minimize the time you're without gas service, your contractor should also schedule an inspection with Elko County Building & Safety Department upon permit approval.



STEP 5

When your Elko County inspection is scheduled, please call Southwest Gas at **877-860-6020** to also schedule your gas meter installation and provide billing information to establish your account.



STEP 6

Your contractor will disconnect your propane and install new piping, if required, to the new gas meter location as marked in advance by Southwest Gas.



STEP 7

Appliances should be converted or new appliances installed at this time as your contractor prepares for the home piping pressure test and inspection.



STEP 8

The Elko County Building & Safety Department will complete the inspection and notify Southwest Gas by installing an exterior piping tag.



STEP 9

A local Southwest Gas representative will contact you to confirm scheduling concurrently with the inspection, if feasible, to minimize any outage, and then come to your home to set and turn on the gas meter and verify proper appliance operation.
